### Overview

Researchers at the Flinders Medical Centre are using a Whole Body X 3D scanner previously used by Fox Studios for digital doubles in the latest Superman movie. The scanner is fast and accurate, taking hundreds of thousands of measurements of the human body in just 17 seconds! The four scan heads collect high speed 3D measurements every 2mm from head to toe. Find out more about the scanner and how Flinders Medical Centre researchers are going to use it.
