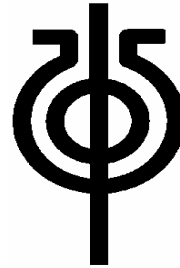

SA Ambulance Service Emergency Operations Centre Site Visit

The SAAS EOC is the state-wide answering point for 000 calls for South Australia with approximately 350-400 emergency 000 calls per day. The EOC also receives approximately 500-600 other incoming ambulance attendance calls per day that combined with 000 calls results in approximately 900 cases being dispatched per day. The EOC houses 20 operator console desks with up to 8 call takers answering calls during peak time. The EOC is also equipped with an Incident Room, which is a special incident control room that is also used for staff training and provides a backup site for SAPOL and SAMFS in case their Communications Centres need to be evacuated.

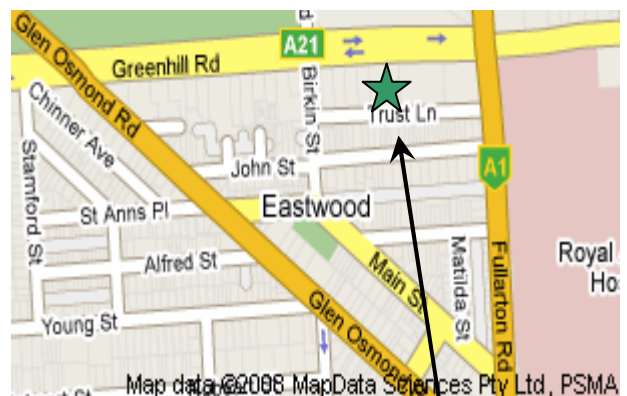
