## Winery BBQ – Sunday, Mar 19th

### Seppeltsfield Winery

**Come on all you wine and BBQ lovers. Bring along your family or friends** to one of the most impressive wineries in the Barossa Valley, near the township of Marananga. It is impossible to miss Seppeltsfield Winery – there are endless rows of palm trees, turret-like buildings (with a faintly medieval air) and strange shaped wine vats. In the 1890s the winery was recognised as the most modern in the world. Nearby is the Seppelt Mausoleum. It is a very ornate building with Doric columns stands on the top of the hill. It was completed in 1927 and positioned so it offers excellent views over the surrounding area.

Structured Tastings (1/2 hour) – A tasting of 5 Seppelt premium wines with complimentary cheese and crackers. \$6.00 per person, minimum of 10 people required. We will try & book this for about 1:30pm

Tours conducted Sunday: 11.30am, 1.30pm, 2.30pm Cost: \$8.00 adult \$2.00 child (5 -17 yrs)

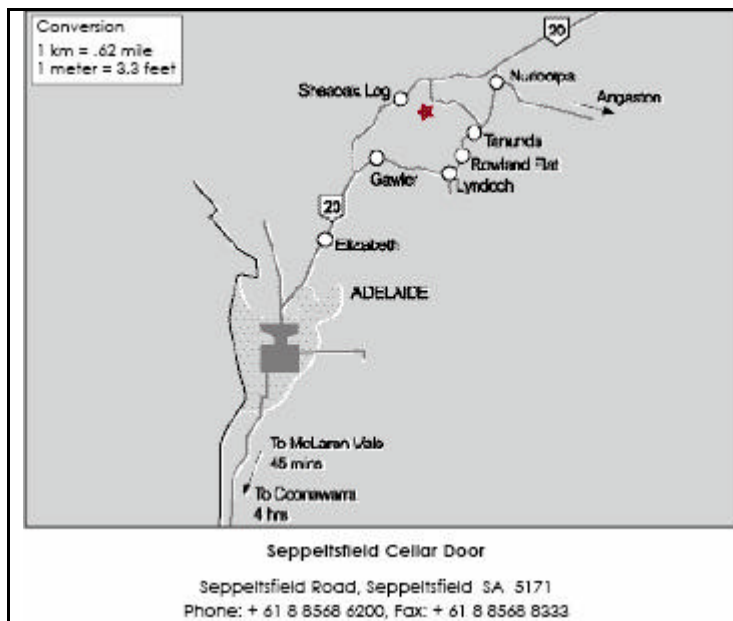
#### Event details:

Head northwards on Main North Road.  
At the Grand Junction Road/Gepps Cross intersection, take the slight right turn towards the Barossa Valley, still on Main North Road.

Continue along Main North Road for about 30 kms and then continue along the Gawler Bypass (A20) (UBD 33 F7).

After approximately 7.7kms this will become the Sturt Highway, continue for another 19kms until you reach the turn off to Seppeltsfield and turn right. Continue along Seppeltsfield Road for approximately 3kms and Seppeltsfield is on the left hand side. Car parking is available in front of the Cellar Door.
